

Musical Rehearsal Contract The Little Mermaid 2018/2019

Students must realize that in order for the show to be successful, rehearsals are the most important process of the production and attendance is 100% mandatory. If students know they are going to miss a rehearsal, they must communicate with Mr. Nate via the instructions laid out in the participation contract.

Students must conduct themselves in an utmost professional way during all musical rehearsals. Complete respect, compliance, obedience, and professionalism is required. Silence when director is speaking, respect of other's space and wishes, and support for the director and fellow classmates/cast members is unconditionally expected. When a student is asked to do something, they will do it.

Students must come to rehearsals completely prepared. All students, especially individual roles such as leads, dancers, lead ensemble members, etc., must look at the rehearsal schedule ahead of time so they know who is rehearsing when. All students are expected to know if they are rehearsing and to plan accordingly.

Students are responsible for their own snacks and beverages. Students will eat their snacks before rehearsals start at 3:30PM and take care of their garbage as to leave absolutely no trace or mess. No food is ever allowed inside the auditorium. Students may and are encouraged to bring **water** to every rehearsal. Water must be sealed in a water tight container/bottle. Any liquids other than water are not permitted inside the auditorium or rehearsal spaces.

Students are expected to comply at all times with anybody in authority. This includes the director (Mr. Nate), the assistant music director (Ms. Hill), Adult Volunteers, and the Director's Assistant.

Unless used during down time or for homework, the use of electronic devices such as phones, computers, etc. is strictly prohibited during the rehearsal process. Electronic devices will be confiscated by anyone in authority and the cast member's guardian will be required to pick them up from the director (Mr. Nate) following rehearsals.

Any student who chooses not to adhere to the policies laid out in this contract may be subject to suspension or complete removal from Hillside's production of The Little Mermaid.
